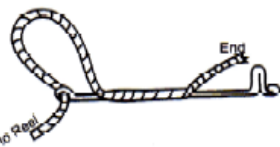
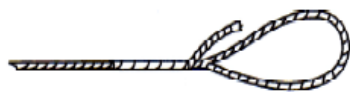


Splicing Techniques

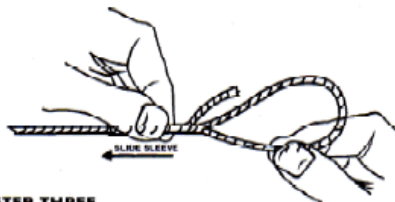
HOW TO SPLICE TO A LOOP



STEP ONE
Insert needle 2" into braided line approximately 2" from end. Bring Point through and pickup line as shown. (Note Loop)



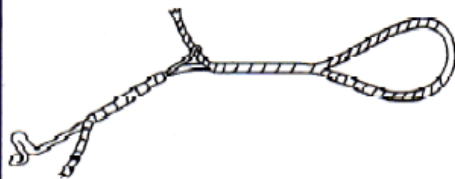
STEP TWO
Pull line through with needle.



STEP THREE
Grasp loop with right hand then slide sleeve over to left so that...



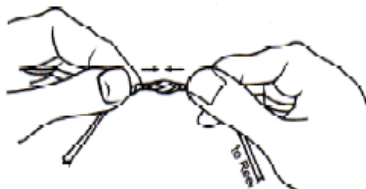
...tag end is now on left side.



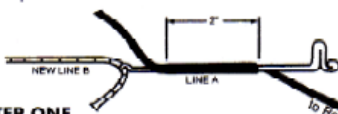
STEP FOUR
Insert needle approximately 3" from end through line coming out 1" from end. Pickup end. Pull out through line, trim end and smooth for finished loop.



HOW TO SPLICE BRAIDED LINE TO BRAIDED LINE



Compress line to loosen weave.



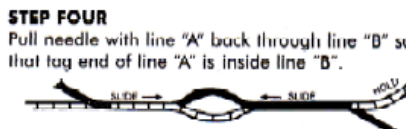
STEP ONE
Open latch, hook and insert splicing needle into hollow center of line approximately 6" from end of existing line "A". After inserting needle approximately 2" into line "A" bring point out and pickup new line "B".



STEP TWO
Pull needle with line "B" through line "A".



STEP THREE
Insert needle in line "B" as done in line "A" in previous steps and now pickup line "A".



STEP FOUR
Pull needle with line "A" back through line "B" so that tag end of line "A" is inside line "B".



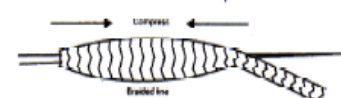
STEP FIVE
Hold tag ends and slide "sleeve" to close splice in center. Trim tag ends at an angle and smooth out finished splice.



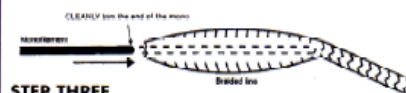
HOW TO MAKE A FINGER TRAP SPLICE



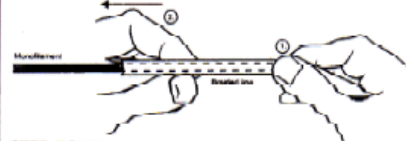
STEP ONE
Insert bent wire into braid and push to desired length.



STEP TWO
Bunch the braid onto the wire.



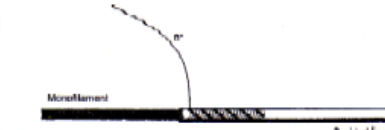
STEP THREE
Carefully pull the wire out of the braid, leaving the compressed braid. Insert monofilament into compressed braid, pushing it all the way through bunched area.



STEP FOUR
Pinch the monofilament and braided line with one hand (1) and comb the braid over the monofilament (2) until the braid is smooth and the monofilament is in the center.



STEP FIVE
Tie a 36" piece of floss near end of the braid where it meets the monofilament with a simple overhand knot. With the long side of the floss tie 30 Half Hitches knots to secure the braid.



STEP SIX
If done correctly you will see a spiral of Half Hitches develop around the braid.



STEP SEVEN
After 50 clip the floss and with the tag end of the floss make another series of half hitches to cover the end of the braid.



STEP EIGHT
Cover the Half Hitches with super glue to bind them in place.
